Thank you for the materials on the Jersey South-East Coast Ramsar site that you have sent to us (correspondence from the Administration in Jersey and the map). Now I'm writing to you to let you know that we continue to receive emails from concerned Islanders about this site, now in connection with "plans to excavate some of the Ramsar Site to construct an access road" (please find below the message that we got recently from Ms Lara Luke).

We would be very much grateful if you could update us about the situation on this site two months after the letter from the Administration in Jersey. We also would be grateful for further more concrete information on this site (e.g. construction plan and concrete planned activities, results of environmental impact studies, especially concerning impact on the Ramsar site) – when this information becomes available. On the map that we received together with the letter from the Administration there are marked "possible areas of development", but unfortunately, it is not clear for us what kind of development is planned in these areas. Thank you very much in advance.

I also attach the comments of Dr. Stephan Funk Phd MSc that we received recently (I'm not sure if Monica already sent them to you and I'm sorry if you receive them for the second time).
